**Our church** is experiencing highlights that we have rarely seen over the last 30 years. New people at church nearly every Sunday – we are nearly running out of room.

We were able to celebrate a **beautiful baptism** service last Sunday – with 10 young Christians entering into a covenant with Jesus.

One of them was completely healed of cancer – which led to her husband and her two daughters (25 and 14 years old) giving their lives to Jesus – all four were baptized.

**Our 6 homegroups** are lively as well. People are hungry to hear, grow and find their “calling”.

We split our **children ministry** into three groups and are excited that our teenage girls are involved in this ministry as well.

**The teenagers / youth** meet at our farm to play volleyball, eat together and to have fellowship in the word and worship. Throughout the winter they continued in the new room for the children ministry – even without volleyball. We are very grateful (the leaders = our disciples = are still very young, 20,21, and 22 years old).

**Our discipleship school** has had more students this year (45 when everybody is present), because the older disciples (that have finished the leadership school) attended with their own disciples. Besides good teaching (we had local and international guest speakers) we worked a lot in small groups. We are very grateful to Stefan Armer (member of the leadership team of our school). Our last lesson was completed during the last weekend in April – but we will come together again for an outreach in June.



**PRAYER REQUESTS:**

- We are praying for our young brothers and sisters in the Lord. Some of them quit smoking and are struggling.
- We are praying for Radu. He is a 22 years old young man who came to live with us three months ago. He is from Petrila and came here in order to cut ties with his group of friends and drug and alcohol consumption there. He decided to follow Jesus completely, was baptized on Sunday and helps us with our daily farm chores. He reads the bible with Misch every morning.
- For the mission outreach in June
- For continued financial support for us to be able to continue our ministry, although prices doubled last year.
- For the new people hearing the gospel: We had a specialist for internal medicine here for two days. He offered free examinations and distributed medication as well. We were able to speak to the people who were waiting and three of those families attended our baptism service.
